To perform the scheme for Science and Technology 2019 and on the occasion of 10th anniversary of the establishment of School of Social Sciences and Humanities, School of Social Sciences and Humanities (SSSH), Can Tho University (CTU), together with Faculty of Liberal Arts, Rangsit University (RU), Southeast Asian Studies Program (SEAs), Graduate School, Chulalongkorn University (CU), Thailand will hold the International Conference “*The River Cultures in Southeast Asia – Preservation and Development*”.

1. Aims

The conference’s main goal is to create an opportunity for local and international experts, scientists to share their research results and experiences in the field of research, preserve and develop the river cultures in Southeast Asian regions.

2. Contents

Articles sent to the conference must be new and unpublished in domestic and international books, journals and conferences.

The conference will concentrate on following main contents:

- The conference will study distinctions of the river cultures in Southeast Asia, the similarities and differences among ASEAN countries, the development and variations of the river cultures through periods of history and the issue of preserving and developing the river cultural forms.
- The conference will examine the interrelation between the river cultures and the development of economy – culture – society in Southeast Asia, especially the development of culture – tourism, sociology and information administrations.
- The conference will study influences of the river cultures on the literature and artistry of Southeast Asian countries.

3. Participants

- Scientists in the field of social sciences and humanities in Vietnam and some Southeast Asian countries,

- Researchers, lecturers, graduate students (Doctoral and Master candidates) and students of Can Tho University, Rangsit University and Chulalongkron University in company with local and international institutes, universities and colleges.

4. Languages: English and Vietnamese

5. Venue and time of the conference

- Venue: **Campus 2 of Can Tho University, 3/2 Street, Xuan Khanh Ward, Ninh Kieu District, Can Tho City, Vietnam**

6. Deadlines and requirements for articles

- Registration and abstract submission deadline: **By July 15th, 2019** (English and Vietnamese)
- Full-text submission deadline: **By August 30th, 2019** (English or Vietnamese)
- Forms of abstracts and full-text of articles: see the appendix
- Ways to present at the conference: Oral presentation, in which selected speakers will prepare his/her presentation by using the PowerPoint software.

7. Regulations on the publication of the conference articles

- Selected articles will be published in the conference proceedings with ISBN.
- Good articles or articles requested by authors would be recommended to Can Tho University Journal of Science (The authors must pay for the cost of peer-reviewing these articles if necessary).

8. Fees

- The fee of participation and publishing articles: free of charge
- Home institutes will pay for their delegates' travel and accommodation expenses during the conference or delegates will pay for themselves.

INSTRUCTIONS ON THE ABSTRACTS
AND THE FULL-TEXT OF ARTICLES
FOR
THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE
“THE RIVER CULTURES IN SOUTHEAST ASIA – PRESERVATION
AND DEVELOPMENT”

1. The article abstract

- The title of article (s) (English and Vietnamese)
- The contents of abstract: the concise introduction of the problem, objectives, spheres of study, methodologies and important findings (150 – 200 words)
- Keywords: 3 – 5 words; keywords will be written in English and Vietnamese and arranged in alphabetical order.
- Forms: Articles will be written on the A4 size (Margins: top/bottom/left/right = 2.5cm) with the double line spacing, the Time New Roman font and the wordsize 11.
- The information of author or co-author: Name, academic titles, academic distinctions, name of author’s workpace, address, phone number and email address.

2. The full-text of article(s)

- Forms: The article will be written on the A4 size (Margins: top/bottom/left/right = 2.5cm) with double line spacing, the Time New Roman font and the wordsize 11. The length of articles cannot exceed 12 pages.
- The propositional structure of a full-text article:
 - (1) Article title, name of author (or group of authors), address of author, email address of main author
 - (2) Abstract of articles in English and Vietnamese
 - (3) Research problem(s), research questions, research aims
 - (4) Literature review
 - (5) Methodologies
 - (6) Research contents: findings and discussions (or findings combine with discussions)
 - (7) Conclusions
 - (8) References

Notes:

- 1) The items (1), (2) and (8) are not numbered. Other items are numbered Arabic. For examples: 1, 2, 3, 3.1, 3.2, 3.2.1, 3.2.2...
- 2) Documents cited in the content of articles must be listed in the references part.
 - Ways to cite a journal article: Author, year of publication. Article title. Journal title. Volume (Issue): pp-pp.
 - Ways to cite a book: Author, year of publication. Title of book, Later Edition. Publisher’s name. Place of publication, pp-pp.

- Ways to cite a conference paper: Author, year of publication. Title of article. Chief author. Title of paper or proceeding. Name of conference, time of conference, place of conference. Publisher's name. Place of publication, pp-pp.
- Ways to cite a thesis: Author, year of publication. Thesis title. Level of thesis (Master/Doctor). Name of university. Address of university.
- Ways to cite a website: Author, year of publication. Article title, date retrieved. Retrieved from URL.

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
